Though the evangelical church in Chile is growing, support for world missions needs to mature to fulfil the church's sending potential. OM is working in Chile to:

• Evangelize- Working with at-risk children/teens, the homeless, and through creative and artistic evangelism in the plazas

• Mobilise- Engaging the church in global missions through church visits, presentations, and conferences

• Train Missionaries- Providing Intensive Missions Training programmes involving classroom teaching, real-world training, and evangelistic preparation



The Middle East field is vastly Muslim, with only very small percentages of the population who are evangelical Christian. Thus, in the Middle East, OM has huge ministry opportunities in many areas, including:

•Evangelism- Providing gospel literature, hospitality, and Discovery Bible Studies to invest in the community

•Church Planting- Sending teams to unreached communities and discipling future leaders of indigenous churches

• Mobilisation of the Arab Church- Providing resources and training for Arab believers to invest in ministry to Muslims and engage the community with the gospel
