Around the world, millions have never had the chance to encounter Jesus, in whose image they are created, and every day thousands get added to this number. Even in Moldova, many districts have no community of believers to demonstrate Christ’s love to its neighbours. Though every believer is called and uniquely created to pass on the love of Jesus, many do not fully understand the scale of the need or know how to respond.

Together, we help to bring a vision of how each unique individual can fit into God’s big picture.



Short-term outreaches in Moldova offer believers from around the world a practical taste of mission, as for a week or two they come alongside various ministries in Moldova, sharing the gospel and experiencing how God can use them to bring joy, hope and transformation, and being encouraged to continue investing their lives in God’s Kingdom.

Specific short-term opportunities for Moldovan groups help them become aware of needs and possibilities for ministry among their own people as well as inter-culturally.



By organising youth events or speaking at churches throughout the country, we seek to develop an awareness of global needs and realities, directing the focus of the Church to what God is doing around the world and how they can be part of bringing His love to those who have not yet encountered it - in their own country and to the ends of the earth.

We encourage the Moldovan Church to pray for the world as well as send and support Moldovan missionaries.



MOBILISING

Followers of Jesus all over the world share the desire to pass on the love they themselves have received. However, many are not confident about how they can share Christ through their lives.

Together, we equip believers for ministry and support them in taking their next step.

Our various training programmes help to prepare and equip followers of Jesus who desire to obey His call, or are already in ministry, but seek further support and growth. Our desire is to not only pass on knowledge, but to come alongside people so they can grow closer to God, find a passion for sharing the gospel and become disciples who themselves go and make new disciples.



MDTe³ (**Mission Discipleship Training** - Eastern Europe Extreme) is a five-month course for young believers from across the globe, discipling and equipping them to take part in creating vibrant communities of Jesus followers among the nations. Teaching and practice take place in Moldova and Romania, focusing on spiritual growth & leadership, mentoring & discipleship, mission & evangelism and cross-cultural adventure.



“**Challenge into Missions**” is a training specifically for young Moldovan believers, where they are helped to grow in their faith and in their understanding of mission, get equipped for sharing the gospel and immediately put it all into practice in outreaches.

We are also constantly looking out to identify specific training needs of Moldovan believers - whether pastors and church planters or new believers - and seek to support them by offering adequate training to help them grow and make disciples.

EQUIPPING

The gospel has spread in amazing ways in Moldova since the country first opened after the fall of the Soviet Union. However, there are still significant areas in the country that have never had any community of true Jesus followers established in their midst.

Together, we get involved hands-on to see this reality change.

In our desire to see new churches planted in these little reached regions of Moldova, a crucial role is played by our **Local Ministry Teams**. These are small teams that come alongside local church planters and live within the local community, serving and reaching out to its people, thus supporting the church planting initiative in its very first stages.



We also offer a variety of projects, especially in the area of relief and development, which - in the context of such church planting initiatives - can be used as **outreach resources** by meeting some of the desperate physical needs present in every Moldovan community. This can mean bringing a daily hot meal to elderly who have no-one else to care for them, offering firewood or warm clothes during the harsh winter months, providing a family with seeds to grow their own vegetables, or running a Day Centre for the most vulnerable children of these communities.

These projects not only care for people in a holistic way - meeting both spiritual and physical needs - but also help to provide an entrance into new places, as they open doors with local authorities and impact the whole watching community.



**REACHING
MOLDOVA'S UNREACHED**

Churches we have partnered with in the past testify that most new churches they have been able to plant were started through such relief projects. We believe that also in the future these remain a valuable tool for reaching the regions of the country that still have no communities of believers.
